Would you like to help understand the tracking of recovery from concussions?

We are looking for people who have suffered a recent concussion and want to be involved in research.

You would attend up to seven in-person visits at one of our clinics (ideally 24 and 72 hours, then at two and three weeks and finally months three, five and seven post-concussion).

At each of these visits, we will take a blood sample from your arm, ask you to fill in a questionnaire on your symptoms and test your eye-tracking ability with a non-invasive testing device.

We are also looking for people who have not had a concussion to be involved in this study as the “control” group. This would only require one visit.
